 - 1. The New Mexico EMNRD Forestry Division will pay 50% of all costs associated with the Emery Gap Fire.
 - 2. Colorado DFPC will pay 50% of all costs associated with the Emery Gap Fire.
 - 3. Colorado DFPC will pay for all costs associated with the Multi-mission aircraft.
 - 4. If total incident cost exceeds \$800,000, both parties agree to reconvene and discuss possible cost share amendments.
 - 5. All available fire documentation will be shared between both parties.
